CHURCH MEMBERSHIP

By joining the Connection Church staff team, you and your spouse (if applicable) are required to become members of Connection Church. As members you are under the leadership of our elders who will expect and inspect your faithfulness in attending, serving, giving, and living.

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Worship and Small Groups Minister is responsible for creating and cultivating a worship environment that points people to Jesus. The Worship and Small Groups Minister must be proficient in at least one instrument, preferably guitar or keyboard. This job would include gathering and building a worship team of musicians and vocalists. Additionally, finding, learning and teaching songs that are theologically sound and conducive to corporate singing would fall under the responsibility of the Worship and Small Groups Minister. A Worship and Small Groups Minister who is bilingual is a benefit but not necessarily a requirement. An estimated one-third of the city of Longmont are Spanish speaking. Our desire is to be one church in two languages.

The Worship and Small Groups Minister is responsible for the oversight of discipling new and existing believers in their walk with Christ through the avenue of small groups. This

includes, but is not limited to, regularly training leaders, communicating weekly with leaders, coordinating and planning events for small groups, and always looking for ways to start new and healthy small groups. This role would also include training small group leaders how to mobilize their groups to do evangelism, outreach, and missions through the avenue of small groups.

As the Worship and Small Groups Minister, you will serve on the Lead Team of Connection Church. Since church plants often require every team member to do multiple jobs, you may be asked to oversee another area of ministry while the church is in its infancy.
